Thus, RP papers provide initial evidence that supports the arguments made, but the final methodological steps related to the paper may not have been carried out at the point of paper submission.

Please submit your paper to the track that best matches your research topic so that it can make the strongest contribution and impact on the research community and increase your chances of obtaining relevant feedback. All submitted papers will go through a peer review process where submissions are typically reviewed by 2 reviewers, as experts in the relevant field.
